## Using Your Family Life Month Packet

- Use as inserts in county newsletters.
- Distribute as handouts at programs.
- Send news releases to local newspapers.
- Send contents as a resource list to agencies serving families in your county.
- Make school packets for teachers and parent resource centers at schools.
- Provide a packet to all the members of your family life committee.
- Provide to local churches as handouts in church packets.
- Share with county resource libraries (Head Start, early intervention, JVS, etc.)
- Provide copies for libraries to share with the community.
- Share with Families and Children First members.
- Distribute copies with local displays.
- Provide directly to clients as a request through your newsletter.
- Send as a mailer to answer client questions and concerns.
- Share with FCE during leader training.
- Plan a program around a Family Life Month topic.
- Provide copies to parent support groups.
- Distribute at senior congregate meal sites.
- Use information in your news columns.
- Share copies at local health fairs.
- Hold a “Family Life Week” fair and distribute packets there.
